## Invitation to Act

On **Monday** 4 November, #TransportWeek24 will kick off with an official welcome from the authorities, followed by a keynote speech. We will have an honest conversation about political leadership and adaptive change.

### Multisectoral Urban Mobility

Tuesday 5 November will be dedicated to multisectoral cooperation and gender transformative systems to achieve affordable and sustainable urban mobility. The second day will be dedicated to learning from the regional experiences in the Western Balkans.

### Standards & Innovation

On **Wednesday**, the regional perspective from **Africa** will provide benchmarking with proven solutions and an invitation not to reinvent the wheel. We will address adaptation in transport. As part of the day, we will open up to the wider ecosystem conversing about fuel roadmaps. We will close knowing the regional perspective from **Latin America**.

### The Climate Commitment

Thursday will be our Conference Day, time for climate commitment. This year, the regional Asian perspective will invite us to achieve the NDC targets. 
