# Time to Be Accountable

## Showcasing Achievements, Driving Transformation

A decade after the Paris Agreement, we reflect on our impact in advancing net-zero transport and the path ahead:

What progress have we made in tackling climate change in the transport sector and what strategies have been adopted?

- Given the complex interrelationships, between government, society, and the economy, as the global interdependency of international interactions, it is necessary to **approach the challenge of transforming transport from a systems-thinking perspective**.
- In past years, we have engaged in dialogue with partnering experts and decision-makers from all five continents. **Enabling insights and experiences**, and a wide range of projects and activities have been undertaken.
- Looking forward, **we see a need to conduct a collective review** of our activities, as this can shed light on how the various components of the broader effort to transform transport have given rise to sustainable and integrated solutions.





# Let's Evaluate How Far We Have Come and what We Have Learned on the Journey

“Tipping points don't work like a switch with which a certain development can be turned on or off.” <sup>1</sup>

- During the week of 22–26 September 2025 we will meet in Berlin to keep calling for action and strengthen our strategic networks, thus enhancing our ability to influence change.
- The conference considers two days training format based on specific aspects of transport. A Symposium Day to blink into the future and visualise our goals by reflecting on the importance of having transport target for 2035. Linking transport with clean energy strategies. Enlarging the ecosystem, we will talk about the role of private sector. As every year we will have opportunities to be updated on what is going on in the five regions of the globe.



# Our Specific Aims for 2025 Transport and Climate Change Week Are

- **Understanding & mapping the system:** We will provide **training sessions based on specific transport related topics**. By shedding light on impacts and real cases, we will enable a deeper understanding of how transformation works.
- **Spotlighting proven transformation strategies:** We will share **evidence-based methodologies for taking stock of progress achieved**. A broad-based understanding of policy impacts in partner countries will enhance accountability.
- **Visualising our goals:** We will look to the future, making ourselves accountable for the need to have clear and measurable transport targets, keeping approaches top-down for policy making and bottom-up linking transport planning with clean energy strategies. By including the private sector in the ecosystem, **we expect to have a holistic understanding of how we can unite efforts to promote a sustainable just transition**, and to develop multisectoral strategies for speeding up transformation.
- **Enhancing accountability:** As a global transport community, we aim to promote more ambitious climate action in transport, based on lessons learned since the adoption of the Paris Agreement. Strengthening our capacity is essential to speed up the transport transformation.

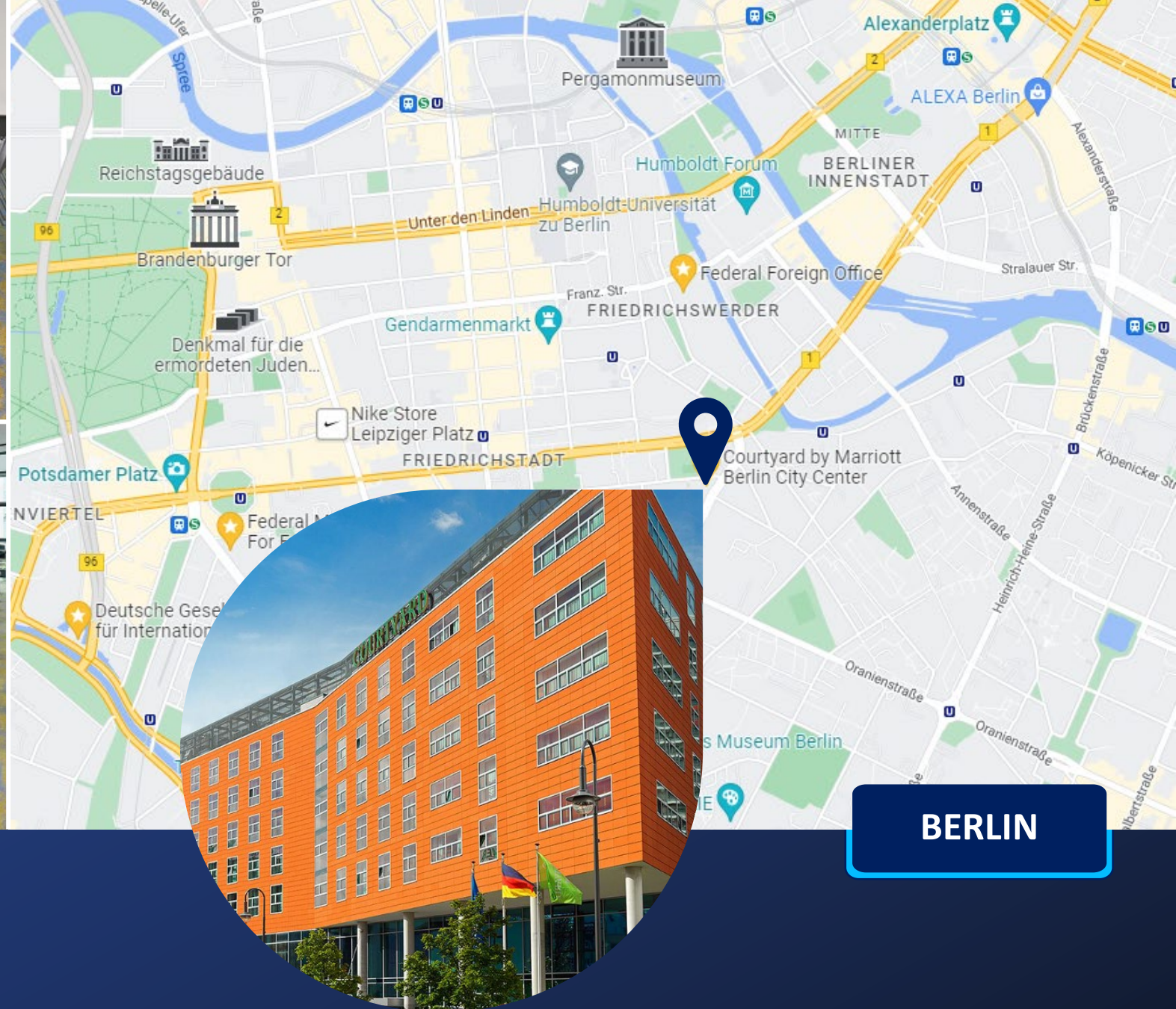
